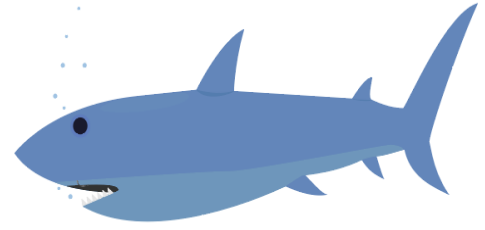

Where's the peck of pickled peppers Peter Piper picked?

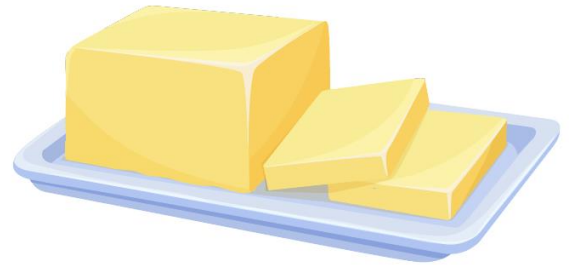


Betty Botter bought some butter,
